

Sunshine's Mystery Quilt 2007

General Instructions and Fabric Selection

This year we are doing a 9-step mystery quilt. This quilt requires six different fabrics. For this design to work you will need to have a VERY dark or black fabric (Fabric #6), A VERY light cream/white fabric (Fabric #4), and four medium shades of fabric which will contrast well with one another. See color examples on the next page.

Number your fabrics #1 through #6, with #6 being the darkest fabric and #4 being the lightest, as shown in the examples on the next page. This is very important! Don't get your medium fabrics mixed up!

Since this quilt is made with paper-pieced blocks, it is difficult to have exact fabric yardage, as this will depend on your method of paper-piecing. Fabric estimates are as follows:

For a 46" x 46" wall hanging:

Fabric color #1:	¾ yard
Fabric color #2:	1 ¾ yard
Fabric color #3:	1 yard
Fabric color #4:	1 ½ Yard
Fabric color #5:	¾ Yard plus 4 border strips measuring ~40" long by 2" wide
Fabric color #6:	2 yards plus 4 border strips measuring ~48" long by 3" wide

For a 72" x 72" quilt:

Fabric color #1:	1 ¼ yard
Fabric color #2:	4 yards
Fabric color #3:	2 yards
Fabric color #4:	3 yards
Fabric color #5:	1 ½ yard plus 4 border strips measuring ~64" long by 2" wide
Fabric color #6:	3 yards plus 4 border strips measuring ~74" long by 3" wide

You can piece the border fabrics from leftover fabric or plan to cut them to length in the beginning.
